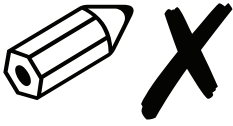

Checklist for the 2010 Fair

This checklist highlights recent rule changes, new opportunities to win and important dates. Check the items that influence your project. Recheck the list often!

Final Checklist before you bring your project to the fair.

1. Did you submit an application prior to February 19, 2010 or through a block reservation at your school?
 Yes No Sorry. You are not eligible to participate in this year's fair.
2. Have you read and do you comply with the rules on pages 18 and 19?
 Yes No
3. Do you have a report to leave with your project?
 Yes No Write one – it's required!
4. Does your project contain any prohibited photos including dissection or other visuals of vertebrates in other-than-normal conditions?
 Yes—remove them! No
5. Do you have written permission to display any human photos of anyone other than yourself?
 Yes No Remove them, cover the faces or get written permission!
6. Do you have any living creatures, yeast, molds, microbes, opened or unpackaged food in your display?
 Yes—Remove them! Use pictures No
7. Does your display meet the size requirements?
 Yes No Resize accordingly!
8. Have you arranged to have your project transported for set up by 6:30 PM on Friday evening?
 Yes No Find someone to help you deliver your project.
9. Have you arranged to be present for Saturday's judging interviews?
 Yes No Arrange to be there.
10. Have you arranged to be present for Sunday's awards ceremony?
 Yes No You need to come! Everyone receives a bag of goodies and at least one award on stage!
