

Flint Area Science Fair 2010 Teacher of the Year Award

Eligibility:

- Must be actively teaching in grades 4 thru 12 (public, private, charter, parochial school) for the 2009/2010 school year.
- Must have at least one student participating in the 2010 FASF.
- Teachers who are related to a FASF board member are not eligible for this award.

Note: Teacher selected for this award is expected to attend the Award Ceremony on Sunday March 7, 2010. Exceptions due to scheduling.

Selection Criteria:

- Nominations will be evaluated by the Teacher of Year Award Committee without knowledge of the teacher's name. The Committee will be composed of members of the FASF Board and the recipient of the award from the previous year.
- Each of the four items on the nomination form will be assigned up to 25 points, for a total of 100 points.
- The nominee with the highest score will be presented the 2010 Teacher of the Year Award.
- In the event of a tie the committee, at its discretion, may split this award between two "Outstanding" teachers.
